

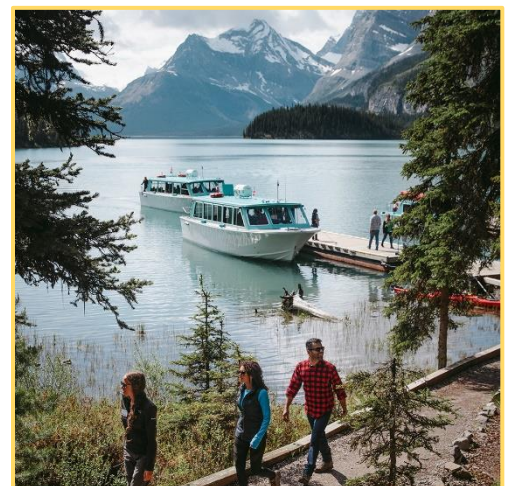
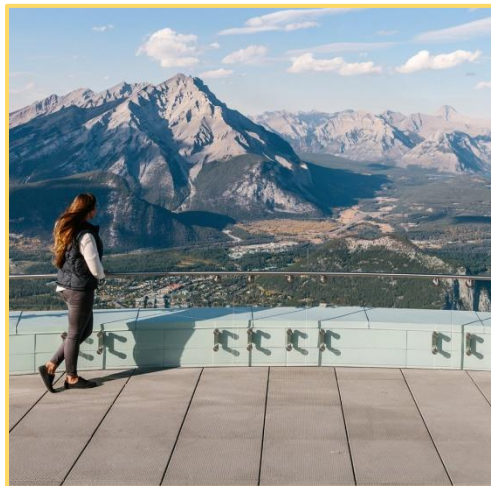

Daily Itinerary

September 22 – Vancouver

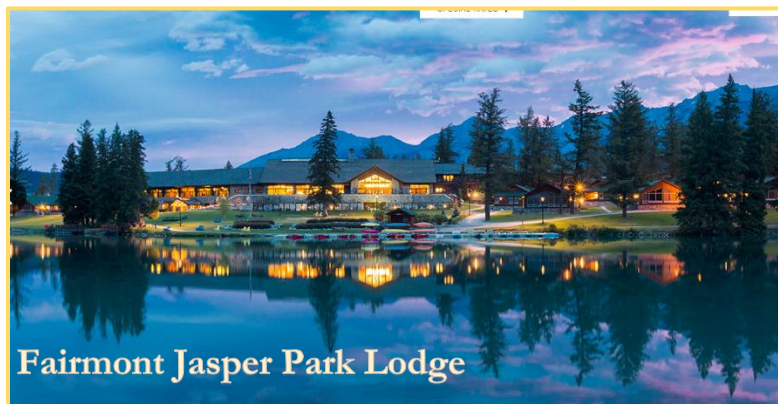
Arrive in Vancouver and spend time exploring this scenic coastal city on your own. That could be discovering Stanley Park, taking a small ferry to Granville Island or much more. Overnight in Vancouver.

September 23 – Vancouver

Enjoy a sightseeing tour of Vancouver and the spectacular North Shore with breath taking views of the city, ocean and surrounding mountains. Highlights include Chinatown, Gastown, and Granville Island, the 137 meter (450 feet) Calipano Suspension Bridge perched above the Capilano Canyon with a stroll along Treetops Adventure, seven suspension bridges through the evergreens taking you above the forest floor. Finish the day with a gondola ride to the apex of Grouse Mountain climbing to 4,100 feet above sea level – at the summit take in the incredible views of Vancouver and the Pacific Ocean. Overnight in Vancouver.

September 24 – Vancouver to Kamloops

Travel onboard Rocky Mountaineer from the coastal city of Vancouver to Kamloops, located in the heart of British Columbia's interior. On today's journey, you will see dramatic changes in scenery, from the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley, through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coast and Cascade Mountains, to the desert-like landscapes of the BC interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River. Your day concludes as the Rocky Mountaineer travels along the shores of Kamloops Lake into the town of Kamloops. Spend the evening exploring the city of Kamloops or relaxing in your hotel room. Overnight in Kamloops. B L



September 25 – Kamloops to Jasper

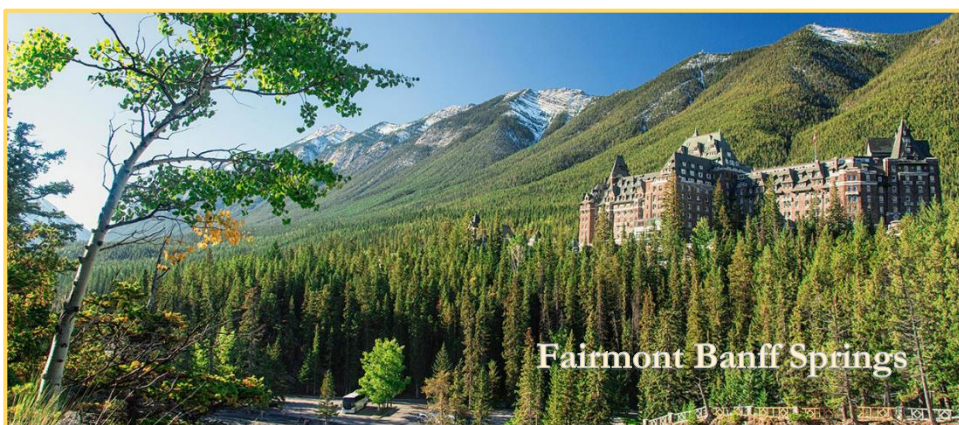
Your journey continues north and east to the mighty Canadian Rockies and the province of Alberta. Once again, you will be surrounded by dramatic scenery as you follow the banks of the North Thompson River through the Monashee and Cariboo Mountains, climbing ever nearer to the high peaks of the Continental Divide. Today's highlights include Mount Robson, at 3,954 meters (12,972 feet) which is the highest

peak in the Canadian Rockies, followed by the Pyramid Falls and the climb over the Yellowhead Pass into Jasper National Park. Breakfast and lunch will be served onboard. Your rail journey ends this evening on arrival in the resort town of Jasper. Overnight in Jasper. B L

September 26 – Jasper

Depart by motorcoach for your full day sightseeing tour of Jasper and the surrounding area. Complete the day with a 90-minute cruise Tour of Maligne Lake and the world-famous Spirit Island. Tonight enjoy dinner on your own at your Jasper hotel. Overnight in Jasper.

September 27 – Jasper to Banff



After breakfast at the hotel we will travel from Jasper to Banff via one of the most scenic highways in the world, the Icefields Parkway. Lake Louise, Bow Lake, the Columbia Icefield, Glacier Skywalk and Athabasca Falls are among the day's highlights. The Columbia Icefield is one of the largest accumulations of ice south of the Arctic Circle and one of the most accessible icefields in North America. Here you will ride on an Ice Explorer to the middle of the Athabasca Glacier to learn about its geological features. Lunch is provided at the Columbia Icefield Glacier Discovery Centre. Afterwards, a brief stop will be made at Bow Lake before arriving in Banff this afternoon. Overnight in Banff. B L

September 28 – Banff

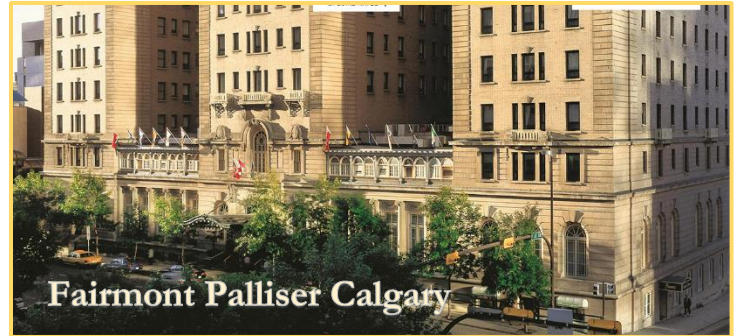
The day starts with breakfast at our hotel before our full day of sightseeing of Banff, including the bustling town of Banff, Banff National Park, Banff Springs hotel and Sulphur Mountain. We will enjoy lunch at Emerald Lake Lodge. Overnight in Banff. B L

September 29 – Banff to Calgary

Today you will enjoy a full-day tour concluding in Calgary. Begin the morning with a sightseeing tour to Banff. Among the points of interest are Bow Falls, Surprise Corner and Hoodoos. Before leaving Banff, you will enjoy a visit to the Banff Gondola. Overnight in Calgary. B
